## What are "related services"?

Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), students with disabilities are entitled to many additional services that can support them in school, including:

## Identification & assessment of disabilities



As part of these "related services", students with disabilities are entitled to a comprehensive evaluation assessing all areas related to the suspected disability that is **multidisciplinary**, **nondiscriminatory**, and **free of charge**.

## Re-evaluation

Students with disabilities are also entitled to re-evaluation of their disability every 3 years to update their diagnosis and related needs in school.
